Pyrolyx AG: Upgrade to Quality-Segment “Primary Market” at Düsseldorf Stock Exchange

Pyrolyx AG, (WKN: A0MFXR; ISIN: DE000A0MFXR8; Primary Market of Düsseldorf Stock Exchange and First Quotation Board at Open Market of Frankfurt Stock Exchange):

The management of Pyrolyx AG is delighted to announce the successful listing of Pyrolyx’ shares in the “Primary Market” of Düsseldorf Stock Exchange.

Since April 12, 2012, Pyrolyx’ shares have been listed at the OTC of Düsseldorf Stock Exchange, now they have been upgraded to the next quality level.

Michael Hommert, CFO at Pyrolyx AG: „Our decision for the listing on the new Primary Market at Düsseldorf Stock Exchange and its higher transparency obligations is based on our goal to raise the visibility and attractiveness of Pyrolyx AG for our existing and future investors as well as for all our business partners.“

Due to its listing specifications, transparency rules and follow-up duties the „Primary Market“ is regarded as a quality segment and all listed companies are obliged to apply to the following additional rules:

- Quasi-Ad-hoc-duty
- Publication of financial calendar
- Year-end financials no later than 6 months after financial year-end
- Half-year financials no later than 3 months after financial year-end
- Company presentation, to be updated yearly
- Amendments of prospectus to be published

The listing on the Primary Market has started today. Schnigge Wertpapierhandelsbank AG, Düsseldorf, continues to act as lead broker.

Due to the shutdown of the First Quotation Board / Open Market at Frankfurt Stock Exchange, Pyrolyx shares will not be listed anymore on Frankfurt Stock Exchange as of December 14, 2012.

Pyrolyx AG owns all intellectual property related to the Pyrolyx environmental technology, especially one patent application and specific process know-how. This unique, innovative process in the field of environmental technology is aimed at commercially recycling valuable raw materials such as Carbon Black, oil and gas from common rubber resins that are produced e.g. from end-of-life tires.
